

Preaching Event

The **preaching text** is printed separately, double-spaced, font Times New Roman 12, with the lines numbered on the left margin for review purposes. It should be for 6-10 minutes (3-4 pages in standard paragraph style). Or it may be written in a style that is structured for oral communication (oral sense lines rather than margin-to-margin paragraphs) and thus somewhat longer in pagination.

This preaching is done in English. However, students who are enrolled in the Certificado en Ministerio Bilingüe whose primary language is English must do their preaching, and thus this preaching text, in Spanish.

At the top of the first page of the preaching text, very briefly state the liturgical occasion (for example, Third Sunday of Advent or Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception), and in the next line list the references for the Scripture texts for that liturgy.

The actual preaching is video-recorded and stored on a USB flash drive (thumb drive). Please be attentive to the audio quality of the recording. The preaching does not have to be a word-for-word proclamation of the written text – indeed, it is usually better if it is not -- but it should faithfully follow its basic development.
